**Third Sunday of Easter** - The Road to Emmaus is a long Gospel passage but well worth reading again – and again: "...he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them...their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight. Then they said to each other, 'Were not our hearts burning within us...?'" Put yourself in their place. Feel how their sadness and fear turned to joy in the breaking of the bread. Jesus is with us at every Mass in the breaking of the bread: Eucharist. Our hearts should always be burning within us.
