Home Schooled Policy -- Grades 7 & 8

Parent as Catechist

The home schooled policy of St. Joseph the Worker Parish is as follows:

- All students must register through the Religious Education Office and pay the registration fee (except in financial hardships) in order to be enrolled in the home schooled program.
- Submittal of all chapter and unit assessments completed by your child/children to the Religious Education Office is required.
Those include: chapters 1-26 **and** unit assessment 1 (pages 71-72); unit 2 (pages 135-136); unit 3 (pages 201-202) and unit 4 (pages 265-267).
- Attendance is requested at church activities scheduled for the grade level, e.g. Reconciliation, Mass and/or guest speakers. All parents will be notified by this office prior to the scheduled activity.
- Homeschooling is not permitted during sacramental years: First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion (grade 2) and Confirmation (grades 9 and 10).
- All students in grade 2 are required to meet on Saturday mornings at the Indian Head School for class.
- All students in grades 9 and 10 are required to attend Super Sunday retreats as scheduled. Retreats are held in the church halls.
